**UKM YOGYA BANGKIT**

Beberapa waktu lalu *femina* menelusuri Desa Grogol, Sukoharjo, pusat kain lurik tradisional di Jawa Tengah. Perjalanan berlanjut ke Desa Kebon, Klaten, pusat penghasil kain batik organik. Keduanya merupakan contoh binaan tiga lembaga yang bekerja sama: Bank Dunia (lewat proyek JRF: Java Reconstruction Foundation), Gesellschaft für Technische Zusammenarbeit (GTZ, LSM internasional berpusat di Jerman), dan International Organization for Migration (IOM). **Puni Ayu Indrayanto**, *Communication and External Relations* JRF, memaparkan, program tersebut berbeda dari umumnya bantuan pascagempa yang berupa uang.
